This privacy policy sets out how the Society uses and protects any information provided by its members.

Information the Society collects

Through its membership recruitment process, the Society collects members' personal information in the form of names, addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses.

What the Society does with the information it gathers

The Society uses this information for the following reasons:

- For internal record keeping
- To keep members up to date with information about the Society via email and post
- To provide members with a means of contacting each other via the Membership List

Members' names only will be used when displaying award winners from the spring and autumn exhibitions, and for members' catalogue entries.

Data Sharing

The Society will not pass on a member's personal data to other organisations or third parties unless specifically requested to do so by that member, or are required by law to do so.

Security

The Society is committed to ensuring that members' information is secure. All personal data in digital form is kept on security protected computers. Written data is kept in locked files. Current serving Committee members and the Society's Secretary have access to this data.

Controlling members' personal information

Under the EU General Data Protection Regulation, members have the right to see their personal information the Society holds, check it, and correct it if necessary. Members can also limit how their personal information is used, e.g. by restricting the amount of their personal information on the Members List, or requesting removal from the emailing list.
