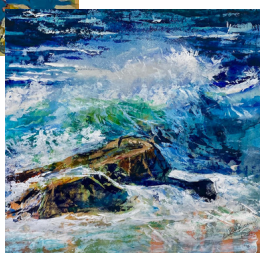
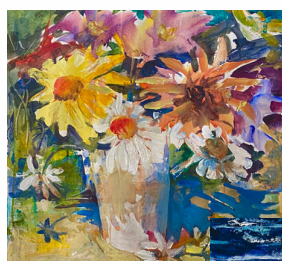


Batik - fishy silk scarf
